Eligibility Requirements:

Scholarship to be given to a graduating Hanover resident (male or female). There is no GPA requirement, but it will be taken into consideration. Preference will go to those students who can demonstrate involvement with the Hanover community, above and beyond high school Community Service requirements.

In addition to the application please submit:

- A high school transcript
- A one-page essay answering **one** of the following questions:
 - Write about an obstacle that you have had to overcome, or about how you were able to help someone overcome an obstacle?
 - Explain how your future studies will benefit your community.
- At least one but no more than 3 letters of recommendation are required as well.

Application may be obtained in the guidance office or by emailing the chairperson listed below.

One Scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$500, but up to \$1000 depending on funding. For 2023 the amount will remain at \$1000.

While applicants can apply for both the Hanover Club Scholarship and The Courtney Neville Scholarship, applicants are not eligible to win both.
